Kaikauhau 3: 1-8

Ka timata te panui kei te pukapuka o Kaikauhau, te 3 o ngā upoko, ki te whiti 1

Ecclesiastes 3: 1-8

Today's reading comes from the book of Ecclesiastes, chapter 3, beginning at verse 1

For everything there is a season, and a time for every matter under heaven: ² a time to be born, and a time to die; a time to plant, and a time to pluck up what is planted; ³ a time to kill, and a time to heal; a time to break down, and a time to build up; ⁴ a time to weep, and a time to laugh; a time to mourn, and a time to dance; ⁵ a time to throw away stones, and a time to gather stones together; a time to embrace, and a time to refrain from embracing; ⁶ a time to seek, and a time to lose; a time to keep, and a time to sew; a time to keep silence, and a time to speak; ⁸ a time to love, and a time to hate; a time for war, and a time for peace.
