Today’s reading comes from the book of John, chapter 14, beginning at verse 15

¹⁵ “If you love me, you will keep my commandments. ¹⁶ And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Advocate, to be with you for ever. ¹⁷ This is the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees him nor knows him. You know him, because he abides with you, and he will be in you.

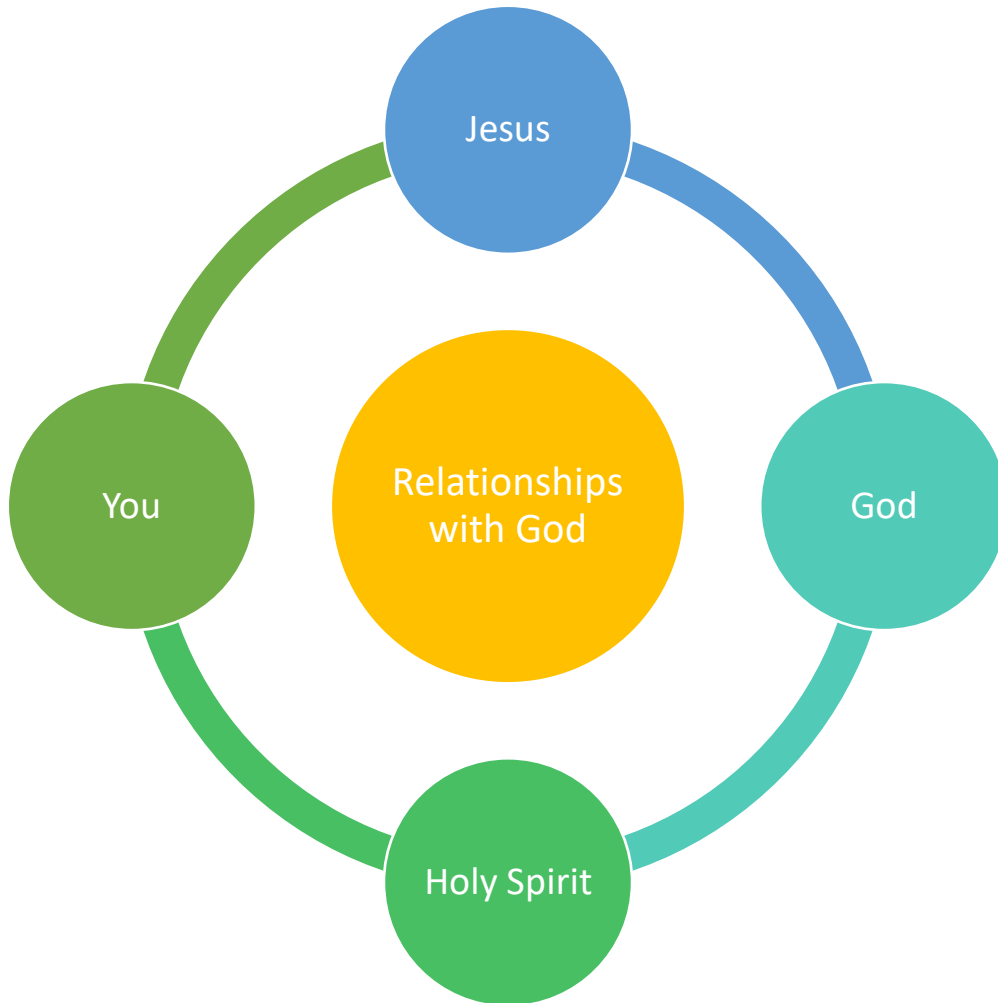
¹⁸ ‘I will not leave you orphaned; I am coming to you. ¹⁹ In a little while the world will no longer see me, but you will see me; because I live, you also will live. ²⁰ On that day you will know that I am in my Father, and you in me, and I in you. ²¹ They who have my commandments and keep them are those who love me; and those who love me will be loved by my Father, and I will love them and reveal myself to them.’





Reflection notes:

This week, maybe the best way to reinforce the message in the reading is with the following picture:



When we look at it like this, it's a full cycle isn't it? All parts of ourselves are connected with God, and all parts of God are connected with us.

Jesus has a very convoluted way of pretty much saying the above. This will be tricky to explain to the tamariki, so instead of a pātai session, let's turn it into an active session...





Ngohe mō ngā tamariki:

The following activity will be a bit tricky, so make sure you read through the instructions, and you understand WHO you should be pointing to and WHEN

You (the day's leader) are **JESUS**. And you are reading today's reading. You are the narrator.

Ask one tamaiti to get up. This tamaiti is **YOU**, the person, the listener. Say to this tamaiti "If **YOU** love me, you will keep my commandments."

Ask another tamaiti to get up. This tamaiti is **THE FATHER**.

Ask another tamaiti to get up. This tamaiti is **THE ADVOCATE** or **THE HOLY SPIRIT**

Say to **YOU** "And I will ask the Father, (point to the **FATHER**) and he will give you another Advocate, (point to the **HOLY SPIRIT**) to be with you for ever. "

Ask the **FATHER** and the **HOLY SPIRIT** to move towards **YOU**. See how they are both with **YOU**?

Point to **HOLY SPIRIT** and say "This is the Spirit of truth. You know him"

Again say "I am **JESUS**. In a little while the world will no longer see me, but you will see me;" Then **JESUS** walks over to **YOU**

As you say the following, point to the characters playing the different parts to reiterate the message: "**YOU** will know that I (**JESUS**) am in my **FATHER**, and **YOU** in me (**JESUS**), and I (**JESUS**) in **YOU**."

If **YOU** keep my (**JESUS**'s) commandments and look after those who love me (point to everyone in the room), then those who love me (point around to those in the room) will be loved by my **FATHER** and me(**JESUS**) and I will reveal myself to them through the **HOLY SPIRIT**'

Notes: You may like to make name tags for each character and get each tamaiti to hold their name to reduce confusion. The following names on a piece of paper should be enough:

JESUS

FATHER

HOLY SPIRIT

ME AND YOU





Activity 1

BINGO Game

Another way to understand how everybody is connected is to play a game of BINGO.

- Hand out the BINGO sheets attached and ask tamariki to fill them out about themselves.
- When everybody is finished, give the tamariki 5 minutes to go around the room and find somebody who has the same answer as you (e.g. favourite colour = blue). Write their name in the box if it fits.
- Try not to get the same tamaiti to answer every box, move around the room...

When you come back together, talk about some of the answers.

Reinforce to tamariki that we are connected in more ways than we think.
