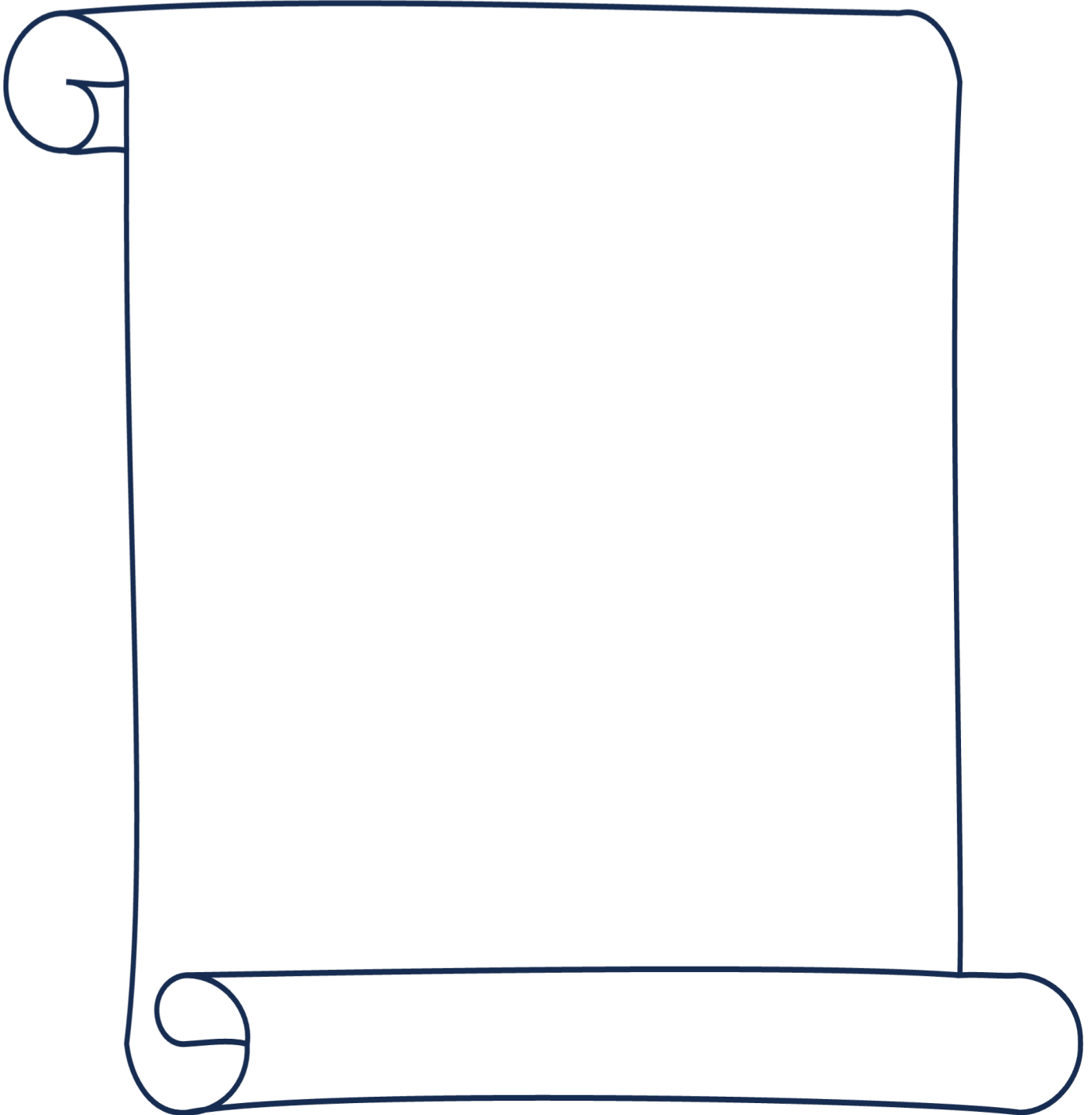
In this week's reading, the King is inviting
