

Ko te pānui mō tēnei wiki, ko te kupu whakarite o te hākari mārena.


In this week's reading, the King is inviting people to his son's wedding.

What would you say to get people to come?




He korero anō i roto i te pānui; ko te ritetanga o te tangata mō te mārena.
